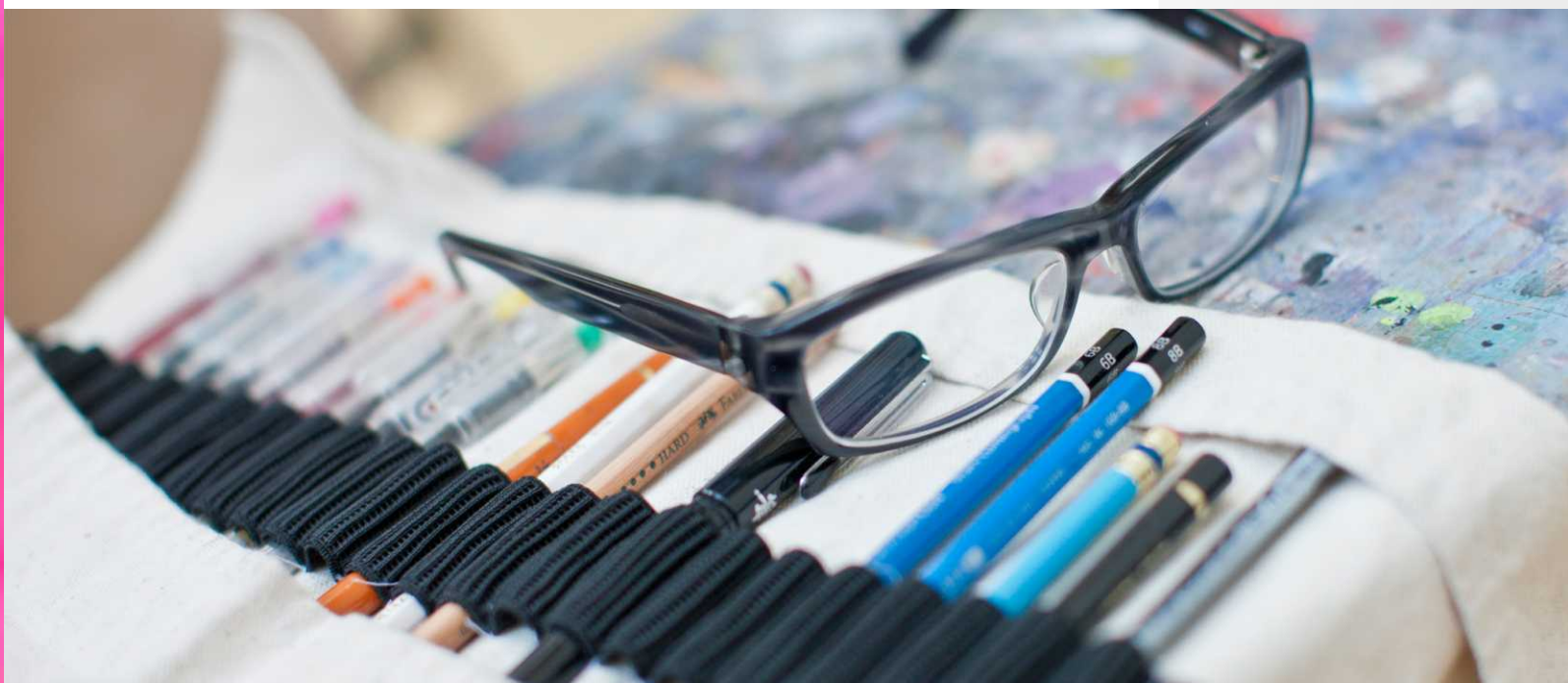

Admission requirements

Program eligibility

Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, with these required courses:

- One English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or ENG4U)
- OR

Mature student status

If you're at least 19 years old and missing any of the requirements above, you can meet these requirements by applying as a mature student. Mature students may be required to complete tests in English, math and/or science or take a FREE preparatory course through Sheridan's Academic Upgrading program.

Applicant selection

Eligible applicants will be selected on the basis of their previous academic achievement (the average of their six highest senior-level credits, including required courses).

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements for this program may be advised individually regarding other related programs.

Note: Art Fundamentals students are required, as part of the curriculum, to study life drawing and painting. This regularly includes drawing the nude figure and the study of human anatomy.

English language proficiency

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English Proficiency Requirements.
