Admission requirements

Program eligibility

Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, including these required courses:

• One English, Grade 12 (ENG4U)

plus

- One Grade 11 or 12 (M or Open level) Visual Arts credit, Communications Technology (TGJ) or Photography and Digital Imaging (TGP)
- Four other Grade 12 subjects at the U or M level
- Minimum 65% overall average
- or
- Two semesters of postsecondary education including required courses with minimum 65% overall average

Applicant selection

Eligible applicants are selected on the basis of their previous academic achievement (the average of their six highest senior-level credits, including required courses), and the results of their creative portfolio, which includes three short-answer questions.

Detailed portfolio requirements, including due date and submission instructions, will be posted in your Sheridan Application Portal after you apply. Please note that there is a portfolio assessment fee.

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements for this program may be advised individually regarding other related programs.

English language proficiency

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English proficiency requirements.
