Admission requirements

Program eligibility

One of the following:

- Postsecondary 3-year advanced diploma, OR
- Postsecondary 3- or 4-year degree, OR
- Postsecondary 2-year diploma, OR
- Demonstrated competence through educational experience and/or related work experience*

Applicant selection

*Applicants with a postsecondary 2-year diploma and/or related work experience will be asked to submit the following information to determine eligibility:

- Résumé: Your résumé should include details of related work experience.
- Cover letter: Your cover letter should summarize your career goals and reasons for wanting to take this program.
- Essay: Your essay must describe two accomplishments in your academic, work or other experiences, which show that you have an aptitude for a career in the Human Resources field.

Résumé and cover letter formats vary by country. Applicants must ensure their documents follow Canadian format and standards. For more information, see: "How do I create a Canadian-style resume?"

The Office of the Registrar will update your application in the Sheridan Application Portal to let you know if a submission is required.

Eligible applicants will be selected based on previous academic achievement OR academic achievement and the supplemental submission (résumé, cover letter, essay).

English language proficiency

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English proficiency requirements.
