Admission requirements

Program eligibility

Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, with these required courses:

- One English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or ENG4U)
- One Math, Grade 11 or 12 (C, M or U)

or

Mature student status.

Applicant selection

Eligible applicants will be selected based on their previous academic achievement (the average of their six highest senior-level credits, including required courses).

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements will be invited to complete pre-admission tests in math and English to demonstrate proficiency.

Applicants lacking the English or math admission requirement for this program may wish to upgrade their mathematics prior to application. For upgrading information, please email academicupgrading@sheridancollege.ca.

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements for this program will be assessed and advised individually and may be considered for other, related programs.

English language proficiency

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English proficiency requirements.
