### **Admission Requirements**

### **Program Eligibility**

Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, including these required courses:

One English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or ENG4U)

Mature student status.

#### **Application Package**

Applicants are required to submit an application package. The detailed requirements including submission instructions will be posted in your Sheridan Application Portal. Please note that there is an application package assessment fee.

Sample application package instructions for reference purposes only are also available.

### **Preparation for Application**

You're encouraged to research the technical theatre field prior to applying for admission:

- Volunteer for practical crew work in professional theatre companies, community theatre groups, secondary schools, dance studios, co-op programs.
- Speak with employed technical theatre professionals.
- Speak with faculty and students at postsecondary technical theatre training programs.
- · Attend theatre performances.
- · Read plays and technical reference books.
- Take photos of your technical theatre work.

### **Applicant Selection**

Eligible applicants are selected based on previous academic achievement (the average of their six highest senior-level credits, including the required courses listed above), plus the results of their application package.

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements for this program may be advised individually regarding other related programs.

### **English Language Proficiency**

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English proficiency requirements.
