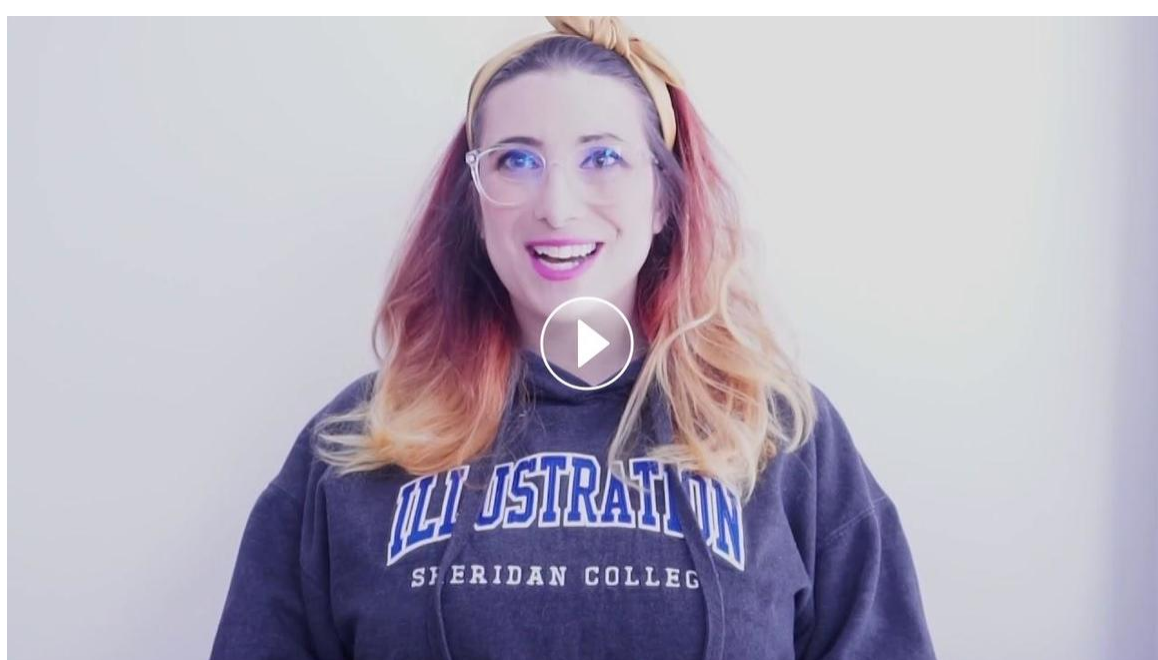
Greeting from Janet Morrison, President and Vice Chancellor
