

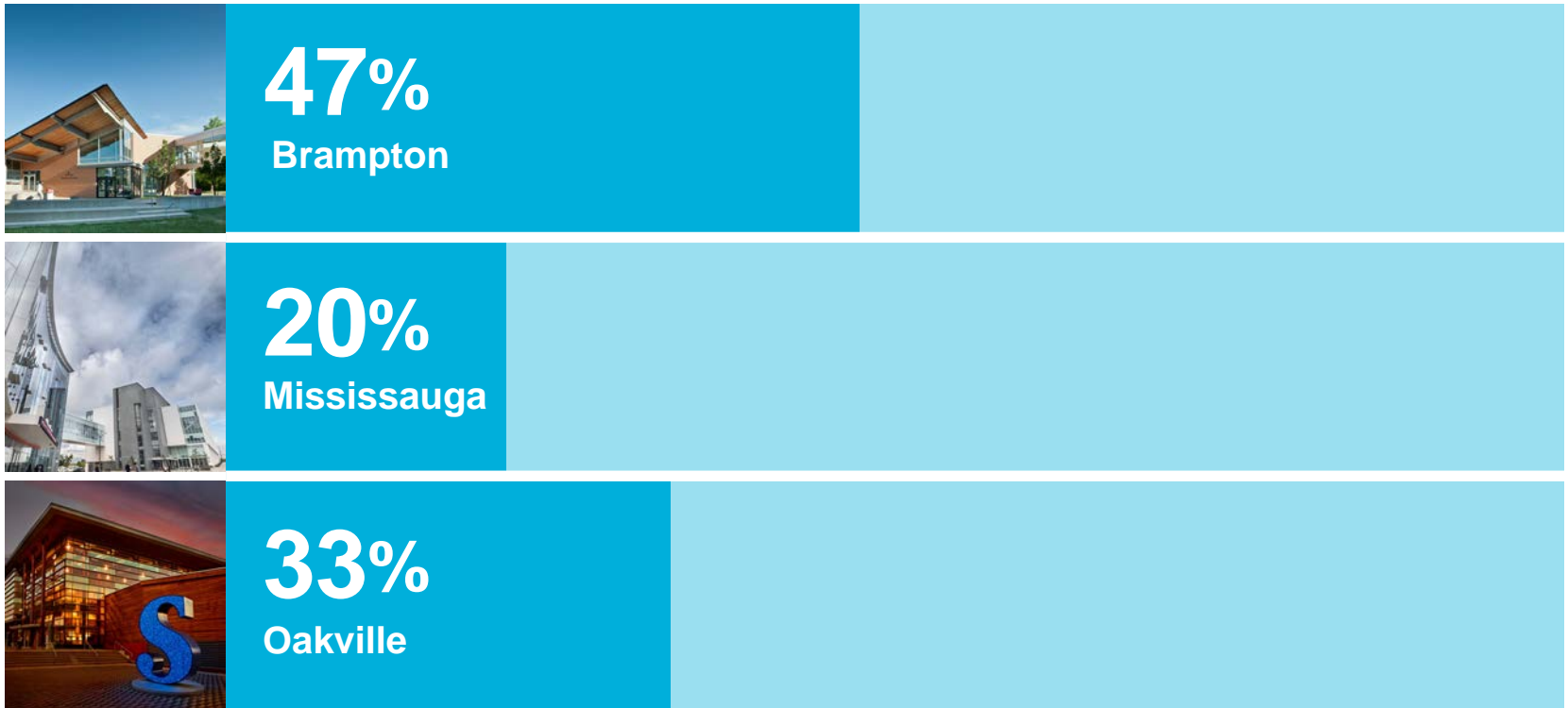

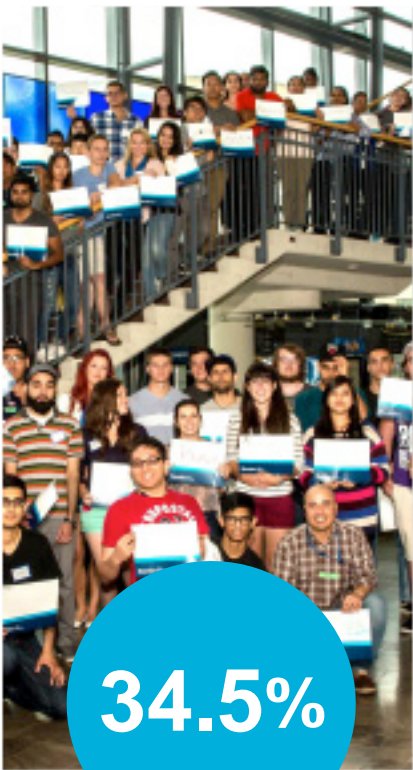

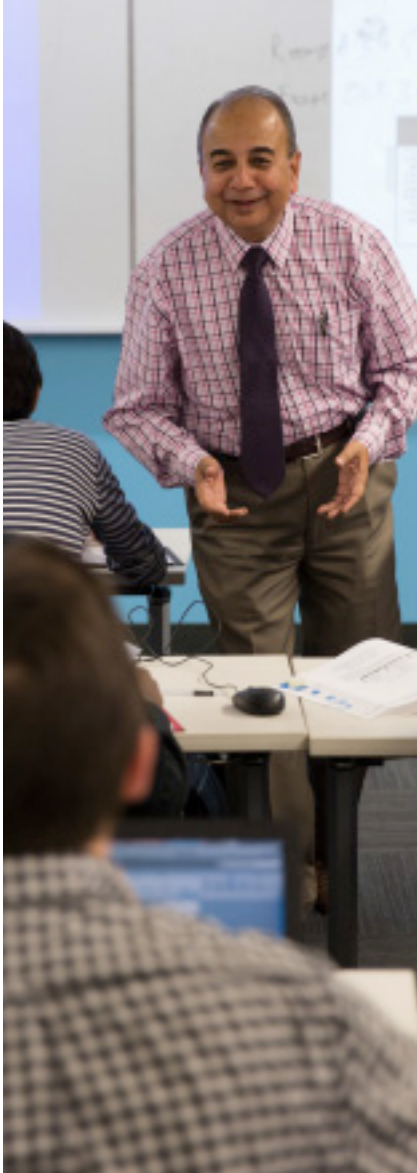

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

All degree programs have a work experience component (vs. half of other Canadian degree students)

80%

of degree students have a culminating senior experience: capstone, thesis, project, comprehensive exam, portfolio:
