Program fees

Enrolment in BUSM 10100D – Becoming a Master Learner (Lecture): This course does not carry a credit value. However, part-time students enrolled in this course **will be charged a part-time fee of \$397.98** in addition to their other course fees for the semester.

Sheridan Student Union (SSU) Health and Dental Plan

You will be required to pay the Sheridan Student Union Inc. (SSUI) Health and Dental Plan fee in full. The SSUI Health and Dental Plan is a valuable service provided by your Student Union. The Plan fee is \$395.00 for full-year coverage (Sept. 1, 2026–Aug. 31, 2027).

If you have coverage through another extended health and dental plan, you can opt out of the SSUI Health and Dental Plan by providing proof of other equivalent health and dental coverage.
