## Introduction to the Credit Transfer and Pathways team

At Sheridan, we understand that every student's learning journey is different. The Credit Transfer and Pathways team is here to help you navigate flexible options that recognize your previous education and experience so you can move confidently toward your goals.

Pathways allow you to progress through the postsecondary system by building on what you already know – whether through high school courses, preparatory programs, apprenticeships, certificates, diplomas, degrees, or established articulation agreements. These routes support mobility both into Sheridan and beyond.

Our team oversees credit transfer, advanced standing, block transfer, articulation agreements, and Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) to ensure your relevant learning is evaluated fairly and consistently. Depending on your completed studies, you may be eligible for entry into degree pathways, provided you meet admission requirements and any necessary prerequisites.

We work closely with Sheridan's faculties and partner institutions to create clear, meaningful pathways that support student success. No matter where you're starting or where you hope to go next, we're here to help you take your next step with confidence.

## Continuing your education

Access to Sheridan's various pathways allows you to build on your existing credentials and experience, making it easier to get credit for what you already know. In addition to a number of pathways within our own programs, Sheridan has transfer agreements with universities and colleges around the world. If you decide to continue your studies at another college or university, you may be able to transfer some of your Sheridan credits.

A Sheridan diploma may also lead to admission into a degree program.

## General transfer information

Each institution determines its own transfer policies, which are subject to change. This brochure is intended as a general guide to help you get started.

For more information, contact the Admissions Office at the institution you're interested in attending. As well as the transfer opportunities listed in this brochure, you'll find that most institutions consider additional admission and credit transfer applications to programs based on general transfer policies. The amount of credit transfer given will vary depending on the institution, the program and your grades.

## Eligibility for a degree program

If you complete one year of study at Sheridan, you may be eligible for admission into Year 1 of a degree program at most institutions, even if you don't have the required degree entrance requirements from high school. There may be additional prerequisites that you'll be responsible for successfully completing though. You must meet the institution's minimum grade requirement to be considered, and in many cases, you'll need to exceed that requirement for admission. Supporting documents such as portfolios, resumés and letters of reference may also be required.

## Are you coming to Sheridan from another postsecondary institution?

Once you've been accepted to Sheridan and have paid your fees, you can access our online credit transfer services to see what previous learning credits may be applied to your current program of study. **Visit our web page** or email [pathways@sheridancollege.ca](mailto:pathways@sheridancollege.ca) for more information.

## Transferring credits

Institutions typically grant transfer credit based on the following:

- + The compatibility of your diploma studies with the program you wish to enter.
- + Your overall academic average at Sheridan and, in some cases, your individual course grades.

Some institutions grant block transfer credit based on the length of your Sheridan studies. Other institutions assess credit transfer on a course-by-course basis (advanced standing). It's important that you check with the Admissions Office at the institution you wish to attend.

## Dual credits

Are you a high school student or recent graduate who has successfully completed one or more dual credit courses?

If yes, you may be eligible to have those courses recognized as credits into a Sheridan certificate, diploma or advanced diploma program. You've already experienced all the great aspects of college learning and higher education, so take advantage of your dual credit experience and approach your college studies with confidence.
