# **Selection Process for Applicants**

Candidates will be selected based on academic standing and/or demonstrated experience, and their submission of a letter of intent, two letters of reference, and responses to a résumé questionnaire.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified through their Sheridan email account. These decisions will not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 8, 2026.

To move forward in the processing of your application, you must submit a portfolio online. The deadline to submit portfolios for the first round of assessment is February 19, 2026. After this date, assessments will be made on a first-come, first-serve basis for the remaining available seats. It's in your best interest to submit your portfolio as soon as possible, as seats can fill quickly.

# **Academic Integrity**

By submitting your Admission Requirements, you are agreeing to comply with Sheridan's Academic Integrity Policy. The Academic Integrity Policy states:

Sheridan College is committed to upholding the highest standards of academic integrity. The International Centre for Academic Integrity (ICAI) defines academic integrity as "a commitment, even in the face of adversity, to six fundamental values: honesty, trust, fairness, respect, responsibility, and courage. From these values flow principles of behavior that enable academic communities to translate ideals into action".

Applicants who are found to have falsified transcripts, cheated on admission tests, or submitted fraudulent documents or in any other way attempted to circumvent the admissions process in a manner inconsistent with the principles of academic integrity, will not be granted admission to the College. Those applicants will be ineligible for admission to any Sheridan program or course for a period of not less than 5 years, after which admission to the College will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

For programs where a portfolio submission is required as part of the admission process, portfolio work should represent an applicant's own ideas, writing, projects and creations. Where others have contributed, or non-original ideas have been included, applicants will give proper recognition and reference. Applicants are not allowed to use advanced automated tools (artificial intelligence or machine learning tools such as ChatGPT) for written or visual components of portfolio submissions.

- 2. How do you feel this program will support your career goals?
- 3. If you could choose a production, what show would you want to work on and which role in the production team would you prefer? Please explain why.

#### TWO LETTERS OF REFERENCE

Please upload two PDF documents: one for each letter of reference related to your theatrical experience. The referrals must be from educators, volunteer supervisors, industry professionals, former/current employers, or from other mentors who can support your suitability for the program. They must indicate your teamwork experience and must be dated within the current academic calendar year 2025-2026. By providing these names, you authorize Sheridan to contact the persons or organizations listed to obtain reference information, per Section 39(1) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Individual Privacy Act (FIPPA).
