- · Artificial snow as well as Christmas trees are not permitted in residence

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- A moving truck, trailers, or extra furniture Your Residence room is furnished. Do not bring any extra furniture. One small shelving unit is permitted as well as a task chair for your bedroom.
- Hot plates, deep fryer or any cooking appliance with an open heat
- \odot Bed risers (Residence beds are already raised as high as is safe for under-bed storage)
- Halogen Lamps, candles or incense
- Pets
- Subwoofers and amps
- Fridges or freezers

- Single serve glass alcohol containers
- Personal internet router
- ◎ Anything which can alter the condition of your room (ex) wall decals, nails (etc).
- Large volume alcohol containers such as mini-kegs, kegs, bubbas
- \otimes Funnels, beer-pong tables or any other high risk drinking paraphernalia
- \otimes Any television larger than 32". Each bedroom comes with a small television. If you wish to bring an additional television you may do so as long as it is not larger than 32."
